SEQUOIA CHARM was squeezed back at the start, raced five wide, rallied at the top of the stretch and was up late. CAGEY LITTLE GIRL was clear early and was just beaten at the wire. VERYLITTLEPATIENCE stalked the pace three wide, bid late and missed. SHANIA TWANG had a belated bid. BRESSIE raced evenly. EXPECT DIAMONDS faded. BURNINGRICH stalked the pace for a half mile before giving way.
