CAPT. JOE BLOW vied for the lead from the rail, cleared the leaders midway on the turn, responded when challenged in upper stretch then was coming clear again in the late stages. RULE BY FORCE was just off the battling leaders from along the rail, eased out for the drive and could make no headway on the winner the final furlong but was clearly second best. PREFERRED YIELD saved ground on the turn while moving into contention nearing the stretch then lacked a late bid. GOLD BANKERS GOLD settled after the start and trailed into the turn then never seriously threatened. SNOWBOUND HALO vied for the lead while three deep, drifted out some in upper stretch and tired. BENJAMIN BABY was five deep in the run to the turn, continued five wide into the stretch and tired. DEVIL COP was five wide on the turn and not a factor. TRIFECTA PHIL was close up in the run to the turn, was four wide on the turn and tired in the stretch. WHISKEY LULLABY was four wide on the turn and not a factor. ABSOLUTLY A TIZZY vied for the early lead from between foes into the turn and tired.
