### Footnotes

PAIGES PRIDE was three wide on the turn, moved into contention into the stretch, lodged her bid a furlong out and drove clear. CLEAR IMAGINE vied for the lead into the turn, took a clear advantage on the turn, weakened some in the stretch but held the place. FIFTY K settled some after the start, was five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. SLIVEN bobbled badly at the break, took the two path into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. JETA'S LIL RED led in the early stages then vied for the lead into the turn, stayed in contention to mid stretch and weakened some. C T'S SUNSHINE GAL saved ground on turn, stayed along the rail in the stretch and weakened. BRANDY TIME raced a bit green while trailing into the turn then didn't threaten. LILBITAGO was only a brief factor early, was five wide into the stretch and tired.
