**Footnotes**

CLAY W. WOODSTOCK was well placed early, raced four wide on the turn, continued four wide and lodged his bid at the head of the stretch and drove clear late. IN STORMS WAY saved ground on the turn, stayed inside for the stretch to lodge his bid a furlong out and finished well to earn the place. HEZABALAFIRE forced the pace, lodged his bid from between foes inside the quarter pole but didn't have enough late. HIJO DE BUENO set the pace into the stretch, responded when challenged at mid stretch then weakened late. I XCELL raced four wide on the turn and didn't seriously threaten. QUARTZSITE saved ground on the turn, stayed inside for the stretch but was not a factor. ARIZONA PROSPECT took the three path on the turn and trailed throughout.
