Footnotes

PATRIATE set the pace while rated on the lead, widened into the stretch and never felt the whip while under a moderate hand ride through the drive. JABANERO was well placed early, chased the winner into the stretch and could make no headway but was second best. EXECUTIVE MINISTER settled some early, took the three path into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. CHISOS STAR moved to the rail into the turn, saved ground to the stretch, stayed inside for the drive and lacked a rally. TAHOE LEGS broke alertly and was in contention to the stretch while four wide on the turn, was six wide into the drive and tired. SWOON'S BUCK was jostled at the break, raced five wide on the turn and into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. IRISH VOLUNTEER saved ground on the turn, stayed inside for the stretch and was never a factor. BARTOCK PERFECTION was fractious in the post parade then remained fractious and unseated the rider twice during the warmup, was loaded without the rider, forced the pace to the stretch then gave way. HOW BOUT OSVALDO showed little and trailed throughout.
