OKIE DOKIE PETEY rushed up between foes early and took charge midway down the backstretch, widened the advantage in upper stretch then held safe a late challenger. CLAIM THE THRONE chased the winner throughout, lodged his bid in deep stretch, finished well and was gaining at the finish. FLAME RAIDER was between foes into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. HALO'S LIMIT moved up while four wide into the turn, remained four wide into the stretch and never seriously threatened. STAMMER had a ground-saving trip but weakened in the drive. MAIL CAR JOHNNY showed brief speed in the run tot he turn, took the three path into the stretch and tired.
