Footnotes

JANZIG AFFAIR rated off the leaders into the turn, moved in hand three wide on the turn, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear. SNOWBOUND TIGER set the pace, responded when challenged then was no match for the winner late while second best. CAFE SILVER (URU) was taken outside horses in the run to the turn, was four wide on the turn and into the stretch then lacked a bid. HYPER SPEED HOWARD stalked the early leader, lodged his bid midway on the turn, was between foes at the top of the stretch and tired. DEEP CREDENTIALS was an early threat, raced three wide on the turn, fell back some then lacked a stretch bid. SCARY MIDNIGHT raced evenly, took the two path in the stretch then lacked any bid. WESTERN WALLY settled some early, was five wide into the stretch and was not a serious threat. EXECUTIVE MINISTER trailed into the stretch, took the rail in the stretch and never threatened.
