R E O SPEEDDRAGON set all the pace, held a lengthy lead into the far turn, responded when challenged at the top of the stretch then drew clear again the final sixteenth. POTRO DESEADO (ARG) moved to the rail in the run to the first turn, took the three path into the stretch and finished well. MISTER COSMI (GB) raced closest to the winner throughout, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch to loom a solid threat then lost his punch the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the place. BLAZE'N LIGHT was five wide while moving up on the far turn, lodged his bid at the top of the stretch to be a solid threat a furlong out then lacked a further response. CRYPTORIA RIDGE was four wide around the first turn, was five wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. SUNSET KID was between foes on the far turn, was four wide into the stretch but didn't seriously threaten. SLEWITION saved ground around both turns, stayed inside for the stretch to loom a solid threat at the top of the lane then tired the final furlong. WISDOM CAT saved ground on both turns but was not a factor. IGOR (ARG) settled off the leaders into the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and tired.
