**Footnotes**

IRISH ERA vied for the early lead, took a clear advantage on the turn, was removed from the rail into the stretch then drifted out further approaching the furlong marker but drew off. IN SHIP SHAPE was fractious loading at the gate, raced three wide near the quarter pole, chased the winner but lost ground down the stretch and settled for second best. A P APTITUDE was just off the early leaders in the run to the turn, saved ground on the turn then lacked a late bid. SIMPLY settled some after the start, stayed inside for the drive and didn't seriously threaten. LOVE LUIGI saved ground on the turn, angled out four wide for the drive and was not a factor. CITY HALO vied for the lead while outside the winner, was bumped by a pulling up rival at mid stretch while tiring. UNTILFURTHERNOTICE broke slowly, was never in contention when he went wrong in the left-front leg passing the furlong marker, was eased, didn't finish and was vanned off.
