TEN CENT DANCE was bumped during the opening furlong, moved up four wide on the turn to lodge his bid then was up in the final strides after a stretch-long duel. TIRYMS vied for the lead most of the way, raced head and head with the winner through the drive and just missed. NUMEROUS XS vied for the lead from between foes, was in tight quarters along the rail nearing the stretch then gained some ground late once clear. EATONVILLE CRUISER joined the leaders while four deep down the backstretch, dueled to mid-stretch then weakened late. LATINO MIX raced four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. VELZIEGELLAUB was just off the early leaders, was in the two path into the stretch and lacked any response. CHORY FOUR was never in contention while racing outside foes on the turn then was seven wide into the stretch. AMERICAN BULL was bumped during the initial furlong, raced four wide on the turn but was not a factor. JADE HALO vied for the early lead from the rail and tired. CHARMELEON took the three path on the turn, angled six wide for the drive and tired. FLAG TO FLY was fractious and briefly unseated the rider in the gate before the start, was slow after the start then rank the opening furlong and trailed throughout.
