HI FLYIN STORM vied for the lead to midway on the turn, took a clear lead and drew off through the stretch. REASON TO CRY took the three path on the turn, eased out five wide into the stretch then was no match for the winner while second best. ARIAT GOLD was between foes into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and weakened. TEXAS ROYAL WHIZ raced five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. NICOLE'S MAGIC saved ground on the turn, eased out four wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. TRUCKEES ROSE vied three wide into the turn, fell back midway on the turn and tired through the stretch. TURBO POINT was very rank at the start with the rider losing his right iron shortly after the start and was pulled up.
