FEATURED TIP broke alertly, dueled throughout, gamely prevailed. EYEAMEASY broke sharply, dueled throughout, just missed. THE LITTLE MERMAID broke sharply, dueled to late, weakened slightly. DOWNTOWN RICHARD broke with field, bit sluggish early, finished well. WHAT I WANT broke step slow, evenly, no solid bid. WILD TELLER broke cleanly, early factor, came out midway, weakened. OPPORTUNITY RUNAWAY broke cleanly, steadied some midway, no threat. FEATURE MOI came in after start, straightened, no factor, no threat. QUIK CHECK stumbled at break, lost best chance, never threatened. FLASH POINT broke cleanly, fell back after start, never in contention. The rider of OPPORTUNITY RUNAWAY claimed foul against both the riders of WILD TELLER and WHAT I WANT for interference approximately 70 yards from the finish but no change was made.
