GOLD COUNTRY took the two path on the turn while not far back, eased out for the stretch, lodged his bid a furlong out and was along in time. TAT STRIDER took a short lead into the turn, widened the advantage on the turn, responded when challenged in the drive and gave ground grudgingly late. STORM WITH CLASS vied for the early lead down the backstretch then settled back some on the turn, stayed on the rail for the drive to lodge his bid and finished well. DESERT DESPERADO was three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch but lacked a solid bid. NU POWER settled after the start, took the two path into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. CROWN ROYAL RUSH moved off the rail on the turn, angled out for the stretch then drifted out further and didn't threaten. RICH GOLD trailed to deep stretch, took the three path into the lane and was not a factor. BRAZILIAN SLEWS stumbled slightly at the start then was a bit rank to handle along the rail into the turn and didn't threaten.
