TACHOMETER set all the pace while rated on the lead, responded when asked nearing the stretch but was kept to his task to the closing strides. RIGHTEOUS THUNDER moved up while outside foes on the far turn, was four wide into the stretch and finished well. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE settled after the start and trailed into the backstretch, was four wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. ALREADY WILD tried to rate around the first turn, was asked for run midway on the far turn, was six wide into the stretch and weakened. SUNSET KID settled after the start, was five wide into the stretch but didn't seriously threaten. BRAT CAT broke alertly and was three deep around the first turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. LAKOTA GOLD was rated into the backstretch, moved up into the far turn then lacked a further response and tired. RESTART forced the early pace and was between foes passing the half-mile marker then tired through the stretch.
