Footnotes

BEST GAME IN TOWN was a bit fractious in the gate, took the four path on the turn, angled seven wide for the stretch, lodged his bid and was along in time. EXCESSTROUBLE was outside a four-horse spread on the pace on the turn, was six wide into the stretch, lodged his bid and just missed between foes. CLAIM THE THRONE was just off the early leader, lodged his bid between foes near the quarter pole, dueled for the lead then was outfinished. MISTER COSMI (GB) raced between foes in the second flight, lodged a three-wide bid near the quarter pole but didn't have enough late. EXECUTIVE MINISTER set the pace, responded when challenged then weakened late. CLURIOSITY fell far back after the start, took the three path on the turn and into the stretch but was never in contention.
