VALARI rated just off the leader through the opening half mile, lodged her bid to the front into the far turn then drew off through the stretch under right-handed urging to the final strides. SIMPLY DAZZLING set the pace into the far turn then was no match for the winner through the drive but held the place while weakening late. PICKIN'WITH DEHLIA took the three path around the far turn, stayed in the three path into the stretch then altered to the rail at mid stretch and lacked a solid bid. LADY KENZIE was just off the leaders into the backstretch, saved ground into the far turn then angled out five wide for the stretch and lacked a bid. MUAH moved to the two path around the first turn, edged closer nearing the half-mile marker then lacked a further response. FATOULS GOLD saved ground around the far turn, stayed on the rail for the stretch and didn't threaten. FLY FANNIE FLY was three wide contesting the pace through the opening half, was through into the far turn and tired.
