HEADED FOR HOME was within striking distance into the turn, came five wide into the stretch, lodged his bid and wore down the leader in the final strides for the score. RULE BY FORCE vied for the lead while between foes, took a short lead midway on the turn, was clear a furlong out then responded when challenged and gave ground grudgingly late. YES TALK TO ME was taken outside the field shortly after the start then rated into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. KING JUSTIN vied for the lead while three deep on the turn, stayed in contention to deep stretch then weakened in the final strides. FLIP THE PENNY was well-placed into the turn, stayed in contention then lacked a solid late bid. A ROYAL TIZZY vied for the lead from along the rail, was through after a half then shifted out at mid stretch when tiring. ACTUALLY saved ground on the turn, took the three path into the stretch then didn't seriously threaten.
