RULE BY FORCE was well placed off the leaders in the run to the turn, stayed inside to lodge his bid near the quarter pole, took a clear lead in upper stretch and held safe a late challenger while setting a track record. BENJAMIN BABY stalked the early leader, lodged a three-deep bid at the top of the stretch and finished well. RUN NICHOLAS RUN set the rapid pace, responded when challenged then weakened in the drive. TRIFECTA PHIL was three deep while not far back into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. LYDIA'S LEGACY was six wide on the turn, tried to lug out even further and was eight wide into the stretch while not a threat. ABSOLUTLY A TIZZY was close up in the run to the turn, fell back some, was between foes in upper stretch and tired. YES TALK TO ME was pinched back some at the start, stayed inside throughout and was not a factor.
