ISLAND HOPPING was a bit rank at the break but then rated kindly off the leaders, moved between foes and lodged her bid into the far turn, drove well clear in the stretch then was being wound down in the final strides. ROLLIN STOCK broke alertly then settled off the leaders, was five wide down the backstretch, was three wide into the stretch and didn't threaten the winner while earning the place. LEGACY NORTH raced between foes down the backstretch, was six wide into the stretch then could make little headway the final furlong. NEW CITIZEN was five wide into the first turn then moved inside, took the two path into the stretch and lacked a bid. VICKIE VEE broke slowly, was three wide around the far turn and tired in the stretch. TOPPER'S GEM vied for the early lead around the first turn then took a clear lead into the backstretch, was in contention for six furlongs then tired through the drive. GRANDMA KATE vied for the lead to the backstretch, was through after a half then stopped.
