Footnotes

LAVIANO rated off the leaders and was well placed into the backstretch, lodged his bid three deep midway on the far turn, widened at mid stretch then held safe a late challenger. DREAMWOOD was between foes on the far turn, was four wide into the stretch and finished well. FREE BRUSH moved up while four wide on the far turn, was five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. NUMEROUS XS saved ground on the far turn, took the two path into the stretch and lacked a bid. FABULOUS RULER set the pace into the far turn, responded when challenged then tired in the stretch. SAND CANYON tried to rate in the run to the first turn then moved quickly to reach the leader into the backstretch and tired in the stretch. PAR FIVE IN TWO settled after the start, was four wide into the stretch and never threatened. THE GREAT BEAUDINI was briefly in contention the opening quarter, was through early and was eased the final furlong but walked off afterwards.
