MISSION DELTA vied for the lead to midway on the turn, took a clear lead into the stretch and drew off under right-handed urging. CHELE was bumped at the break, lugged out on the turn and was six wide into the stretch then finished willingly once straightened for the drive. SHREWD PROSPECT was never far back, lodged a three-wide bid near the quarter pole, couldn't go with the winner through the drive then was outfinished for the place. PAULS PROMICE broke in and bumped a rival at the break, was steadied briefly in the run to the turn, took the two path into the stretch and lacked a bid. FIRST OPPORTUNITY broke out at the start but was straightened and forced the pace into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and drifted out through the drive. AGGRAVATED BATTERY was bumped at the break, saved ground on the turn, stayed on the rail for the stretch and lacked a bid. LUCKY MASA vied for the lead, was between foes to the stretch and tired the final furlong.
