SANFIRE vied for the lead from along the rail, took a clear lead into the stretch then drew off and was under right-handed urging to the closing strides. SAINT SPIRIT was steadied when rank to handle in the run to the turn, was taken four wide on the turn, raced between foes at mid stretch then earned the place while no threat to the winner. MS PAINT IT BLACK was three wide into the turn, came seven wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. SHES A GO GO GIRL vied for the lead outside the winner, stayed in contention to mid stretch then tired the final furlong. CURE AUTISM was seven wide on the turn, moved in at upper stretch and took the three path the rest of the way while not a factor. TURBO POINT was six wide on the turn, moved in to the two path for the drive and was not a serious threat. ARIAT GOLD raced six wide on the turn, was five wide into the stretch and tired. SCARLET RHYTHM bobbled to her nose at the break and lost the rider.
