Footnotes

NOSIR rated off the leaders, lodged a three-deep bid into the far turn, took charge on his own courage then was ridden out through the stretch while receiving a couple of right-handed taps. TRIFECTA PHIL vied for the lead, then lodged his bid along the rail into the far turn but was no match for the winner while second best. CONFIDENTIAL CALL settled in the early stages, was between foes midway on the final bend, took the two path into the stretch but lacked a solid bid. GOLD BANKERS GOLD was between foes around the first turn, was four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and didn't seriously threaten. SLASHIN TIGER was four wide around the first turn, moved up briefly into the far turn then lacked a further response. GRANDPA ROY set the pace to past the half-mile marker, had little response when headed from both sides into the far turn and tired in the stretch. BARCLAY DRIVE saved ground around the first turn while in contention, dropped back after a half, took the two path into the stretch and tired. MARITIME COMMANDER was five wide around the first turn and was never a factor.
