MICKEY ROCKS rated off the leaders down the backstretch, lodged his bid midway on the far turn and quickly opened up the lead, drew off through the stretch and was kept to task to the final strides. EDMOND was three deep in the run down the backstretch, lodged his bid into the far turn and took a short-lived lead, then was no match for the winner through the stretch while clearly second best. JUST JEBICAH lagged far back early, was six wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. TACHOMETER vied for the lead and remained a contender to near the quarter pole then tired. WHO'S RALPH settled after the start then didn't seriously threaten. KEYSTOTHESTORM stumbled slightly at the break then rushed up along the rail and vied for the lead then tired after six furlongs. FABULOUS SNOOP was six wide into the first turn, raced three deep nearing the half-mile pole then tired. BRYANT raced inside throughout and tired. RIDE THE BULL rated off the early lead, moved up between foes near the half-mile marker then stopped after six furlongs. This race was hand timed.
