Footnotes

JANZIG AFFAIR vied for the lead outside a three-horse spread, took a short lead on the turn, then gamely prevailed late after a stretch-long drive while bumping with the runner-up twice in the final strides. CAT'S GOLD vied for the lead from between foes throughout, bumped with the winner from between foes in the closing strides and missed after a prolonged drive. GIMME S'MOR vied for the lead from the rail throughout but wasn't good enough and was the third head on the wire. BARTOKS BRAVEHEART saved ground on the turn, stayed inside for the drive and lacked a solid bid. WOBBLY FELLOW moved four wide into the turn, was five wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. EMPEROROFTHERACES was a bit fractious in the gate before the start, took the three path on the turn and into the stretch and was not a factor. HYPER SPEED HOWARD settled off the leaders after the start but was through early and stopped. A claim of foul by the rider of CAT'S GOLD against the rider of the winner for interference in the late stages was not allowed.
