SKEEMAN trailed after the start, saved ground on the turn while moving up, eased out nearing the stretch and lodged his bid a furlong out and drove clear late. JUNE'S PRINCE took the lead shortly after the start, set the pace to the stretch, responded when challenged then couldn't match strides with the winner but was easily second best. NUMEROUS XS settled after the start, took the three path into the stretch, eased out further at mid-stretch then lacked a bid. WOODTOWN BOB trailed and took the three path into the stretch then lacked any bid. MY RAHY was never far back, raced outside on the turn, came seven wide for the drive and tired. CRESCO GAMBLER vied for the lead from the rail into the turn, stayed inside and tired in the stretch. TOO COOL was reluctant to load then forced the pace into the turn while between foes then was drifting out while tiring in the stretch. THUNDER MATT was four deep on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and tired.
