Footnotes

IN SHIP SHAPE set the pace while being rated on the lead, responded when asked into the stretch then was ridden out the final furlong. DISTORTED SKY was never far back, gradually advanced on the far turn, came in slightly late then and could make little headway the final furlong while earning the place. KING KAMEHAMEHA settled some after the start, was between foes through the stretch and gained some ground late. BABY FISH was well placed down the backstretch behind the winner, fell back some into the far turn, was five wide into the stretch and gained some ground late. ARIZONA PROSPECT settled off the winner down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, stayed along the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late response. MARION'S CHOICE broke slowly and was left behind his field, advanced down the backstretch, moved inside and saved ground around the far turn then lacked a solid bid. TOM N' CHERRY tried to rate around the first turn, was through after a half then stopped in the stretch. The stewards posted the inquiry sign over a minor incident in deep stretch between KING KAMEHAMEHA and DISTORTED SKY but no change was made in the order of finish. This race was hand timed.
