REASON TO CRY vied for the lead to the stretch, drew clear in upper stretch then was ridden out to the closing strides while increasing the advantage. RIO BRILLA vied for the lead to the stretch then was no match for the winner while clearly second best. PLEASURE PROSPECT angled out nearing the stretch, was four wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. MUAH saved ground while moving on the turn, stayed inside for the stretch and weakened. KELLEY'S MAGIC was four deep in the run to the turn and never seriously threatened. AMP UP went in the air at the break but quickly recovered and forced the pace and tired. THREE ON RED was bumped at the break and lagged after the start then trailed throughout.
