PURE VERTICAL dueled, assumed command far turn, just lasted. OUR DOUBLE O SEVEN steady advance on rail, closed with a rush. THE FUSA dueled, gave way far turn, came again, just missed. C B ROWDIE ONE 3 wide first turn, evenly, lacked late response. IRON WORKER GEORGE unhurried early, closed willingly on rail. FRIENDLY LINDY void early speed, trailed, passed tiring rival late, no factor. DERBYOSEVEN 4 wide first turn, middle of pack, empty far turn, faded.
