MS HOMETOWN STAR pressed the early pace four wide, dueled into the stretch and edged clear nearing the wire. NO MORE DAY'S set a pressured early pace three wide, dueled into the stretch, failed to match strides and yielded nearing the wire. REUBENS WATCH was off slow early racing four wide, began to close the gap in the turn, drifted out seven wide in the stretch and closed late. GHOSTLY WITCH was unhurried early, went three wide to place a brief bid then went evenly late. WAVIN'GOLD was within striking distance early saving ground, swung out four wide then weakened. RED'S MOCHA trailed the field and was not a factor.
