MR. GOLDEN RULER broke sharply to set the early pace, held a safe advantage throughout and proved best. CHIMNEY SWEEP stalked the early leaders along the rail, drifted out three wide into the stretch and showed some effort late. HE'S MY DESSERT was unhurried early, vied into the turn between rivals, then went evenly in the stretch lacking a gain late. OUTTA TUNE was allowed to settle early three wide, drifted out six wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. BALLISTIC HEAT was void of early speed saving ground and failed to threaten. MS. SALT MINE forced the early pace from the outside and was finished early.
