DRUNK DIAL moved up along the rail to set the early pace, edged clear into the turn and drew off in the stretch. DR. DIZZLE prompted the early pace five wide, sustained a bid showing some effort late but was no match for the winner. NOAH BY STORM was allowed to settle early, rallied four wide and was along for the show. NATURAL DREAMS was unhurried early racing off the inside, made a move mid way then when weakened. F D ICY forced the early pace from between foes then gave way. POLISH QUEST was off slow early racing well off the rail trailing the field, drifted out seven wide in the stretch and was not a factor.
