STORMY EXPRESS was unhurried early racing four wide, rallied nearing the quarter pole, gained the lead at the eighth pole and drew off in the stretch. MISS HEATHER LEE was off slow early, placed a steady effort five wide and was up for the place. SLIVEN pressed the early pace from the outside, placed a bid to draw clear in the turn then came up empty in the drive. NO OTHER TONE was void of early speed racing off the inside, angled out three wide and sustained a mild bid. FACIL CATANA stalked the early leaders three wide, made a move mid way then faded. APOLLEAN was forwardly placed early racing off the rail then gave way. PETITION THE LADY showed early speed along the rail, went wrong near the five sixteenths, was taken up and vanned off. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
