COPE'S ANGEL was within striking early, placed a bid five wide in the stretch, moved up on even terms, dueled to the wire between foes, was all out at the wire and just up. MONEYINPARENTHESSES was unhurried early, rallied in the stretch on the outside, advanced to duel to the wire, fought gamely but was out noddod. SANTE FE DREAMIN was off slow early, went six wide in the stretch, found her best stride late and was gaining. DIABLA forced the early pace between foes, moved up to challenge the leader, battled hard to the wire but didn't have enough late. BAY OLIVIA moved up along the rail to set a pressured early pace, held to the final yards and gave way grudgingly. BETTERNILOOK was allowed to settle early racing well off the rail, went eight wide in the stretch and lacked a gain late. SHEZ OUR INFLUENCE chased the early leaders saving ground, placed a brief bid then weakened. DAR LIN DAN YELLA raced wide and was not a factor. PATROLLING pressed the early pace three wide, then tired and stopped.
