DEPOT RED stalked the early leader four wide, rallied into the turn, drew clear and increased his advantage through the stretch. HOLLYWOOD JAZZ was forwardly placed early three wide, showed some effort late to gain the place but was no match for the winner. SPEEDY DOMZALEZ pressed the early pace, battled into the top of the stretch then came up empty. PAL O DOME was void of early speed saving ground and showed some interest late four wide. RISKY REASON raced mid pack five wide, sustained a mild bid into the turn then went evenly. GRANNY'S SONG was outrun early, went five wide and placed a mild effort. B. A. CON was unhurried early saving ground and lacked a rally. SODA DANCER was void of early speed saving ground, drifted out wide into the stretch and improved his position. TRADERS TURN set a pressured early pace racing off the inside then retreated steadily after a half. BORN BOND raced wide in the stretch and failed to menace.
