Footnotes

NUN LIKE ME set the early pace drawing clear, opened up into the turn and was kept to task to the wire. BROTHER JIM prompted the early pace from along the inside, angled out four wide into the stretch to place a bid, drifted out nearing the wire and showed some good effort late. SIR STEPHEN was unhurried early saving ground, rallied into the stretch, finished with urging drifting out some and was outfinished for the place. EMPIRE HOUSE was forwardly placed early, placed a bid between rivals nearing the eighth pole, was jostled nearing the sixteenth pole then yielded. SIZZLING FARGO raced mid pack and lacked a late effort. CONDENSED was void of early speed and placed a mild bid on the rail late. HALOBEGONE made a move into the turn six wide then gave way. RUSSIAN LIQUOR showed little, went six wide at the three sixteenth and placed a dull effort. AUDIENCE failed to threaten. There was a Stewards Inquiry and after reviewing the films it was determined that BROTHER JIM would be disqualified and placed fourth for interference in the stretch.
