Footnotes

THE HALO KID set the early pace drawing clear while saving ground, drifted off the rail in the stretch and drew off. DIAMOND CHARM chased the early leaders racing off the rail, went between foes in the turn, finished willingly but was no match for the winner. GOOD NITE GRACE was outrun early, raced wide throughout and closed mid track to get up for the show. DANGEROUS HEART was forwardly placed, went five wide and weakened. SLEWFULS STAR was void of early speed, went five wide and placed a mild bid. DANCEFORJONESZIE raced mid pack, sustained a brief bid along the rail then gave way. PARTICULAR forced the early pace from the outside, was finished early and faded. DEVIL'S PROSPECTOR showed little in a dull effort.
