**Footnotes**

SCOOBA DE was close in the early going, then settled back angling out four wide, rallied in the stretch and surged clear in deep stretch. FLY LESTER FLY was forwardly placed between foes, angled out nearing the eighth pole, battled to nearing the wire with SCOOBA DE then yielded in the final going. PACHE OF GOLD set the early pace, drew clear briefly near the quarter pole, was challenged at the eighth pole then flattened and held the show. TOP DANCER pressed the early pace from between rivals, dueled briefly in the stretch then weakened. MOORE BULL was off slow early racing well off the inside was the widest in the stretch and lacked a bid. RADCLIFFE MAN prompted the early pace from between foes then gave way.
