TRENDY COPY was away alertly, set the pace along the rail, drew off in the stretch and was ridden out to the wire. ABBY CITY raced mid pack early, was fanned six wide into the lane and showed a good late rally. BOONE BABY settled off the rail early and closed willing between foes. POSOLE pressed the pace from two wide and weakened. DAME FONTEYN stalked the pace while racing three wide on the turn and also weakened late. MADAMMAZEL was away alertly to show brief foot and faded after a half. MAKEMINEAMOCHA was unhurried early and improved her position late. CATHERINE AGAIN pressed the pace along the rail for a half mile and tired. EXTRA SWIFT raced in mid pack, was seven wide on the turn and showed no rally. WIN NEED raced nine wide out of the turn and never threatened. LADY CRICKET was off slow, veered out after the start, drifted out throughout and raced greenly. LITTLE JERMAINE was always outrun.
