SLAMIT set the early pace from the outside, dueled down the backstretch, dug in mid stretch and drew clear. RISK DRAG forced the early pace from along the inside, dueled down the backstretch, fought hard but was outfinished. WARSHAW was allowed to settle early racing off the rail, angled out four wide, battled for the show spot and prevailed. GLENBEIGH was unhurried early racing off the inside, sustained a bid to fight for the show but was outfinished. THE HUNT IS ON was outrun early, went four wide and lacked a late response. PERFECT VERVE was off slow to be void of early speed, angled out four wide in the stretch and improved his position. TIZZAM raced mid pack four wide then gave way. DR. HUDSON showed little in a dull effort.
