FOURTEEN KT. GOLD was unhurried early, went six wide circling the field, was urged steadily through the stretch and inched away. D J'S DIAMOND broke sharply to set the early pace, dueled into the stretch then yielded and was outfinished. ON DOWN THE ROAD prompted the early pace four wide, sustained a bid to duel in deep stretch then weakened. ADMIRAL'S CROWN raced mid pack off the inside and lacked a late effort. HUNTING DIXIE moved up between rivals down the backstretch three wide, dueled briefly in the turn then gave way. DESERT GULCH was off slow early, went six wide and placed a mild effort. CHASING OUR DREAMS showed little in a dull effort. DECEMBER BOY failed to threaten. FLASH ME THE CASH was forwardly placed between foes then retreated.
