KOLETA'S DANSEUR was off slow early, went four wide gaining steadily into the turn while circling the field six wide and wore down his rivals through the stretch and surged clear. LOUIE'S BROTHER set the early pace racing four wide, was challenged in the turn, then rallied to edge clear into the stretch and flattened in the lane racing five wide. CASH SOURCE forced the early pace four wide, placed a bid to gain a short led in the turn then weakened in the stretch. SWEEP N HOME prompted the early pace, went five wide and lacked a late effort. DAYBERRY raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a late response. OLD CHARTER WHO was unhurried early racing off the rail, drifted out three wide then gave way. TIMPANI showed little in a dull effort.
