TEA TIME WARRIOR was unhurried early, vied four wide in the stretch, wore down his foes through the stretch and drew clear. GALA VANZUZ set the early pace, dueled briefly into the stretch, yielded in the drive but held the show. CAPTAIN JAZZ forced the early pace from the inside, gained the lead briefly at the eight pole but was outfinished. MOY'S SHOES stalked the early leaders three wide, angled out five wide and lacked a gain late. PASS THE TIME raced mid pack saving ground and lacked a closing response. DIESEL INJUN dropped back early racing off the rail and improved his position. SINGER'S PROSPECT made a move mid way then faded racing wide. SUENOS HOPE showed little in a dull effort.
