LOVELY MEMORY stalked the early leaders four wide, vied nearing the quarter pole, responded well when asked, surged clear and drew off in deep stretch. SASS was off slow early racing off the rail, placed a bid angling out into the stretch and showed some late effort to get up for the place. HONOR AND PRAISE set the early pace racing off the rail, was challenged nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. GRAY HARE broke slow at the start, settled into stride, rallied in the stretch splitting foes four wide and showed some late interest. RUNNING WAGER was void of early speed, gained steadily to the top of the stretch and went evenly. CLIMB AND MAINTAIN was off slow early, circled the field racing widest into the stretch and lacked a gain late. RALLY THE REBELS shuffled back in the turn, went three wide at the quarter pole, lacked a gain late. SILENT HYMN was forwardly placed early three wide and was finished early. LAWFULENTRY forced the early pace between foes, was hard used and gave way. MS JADE HUNTRESS moved up along the rail to contend briefly at the quarter pole then retreated. WOODY WOMAN retreated steadily.
