CAPE TIME broke sharply to draw quickly clear, held a safe advantage and was kept to task to the wire. INDIAN WEAVER prompted the early pace from the outside, rallied three wide, was gaining slowly but didn't have enough late. A LOT OF MON was off slow early racing off the rail, drifted out four wide to place a bid, then shifted inward near the sixteenth pole and closed late. EGYPT (GB) tracked the early leaders, angled out four wide near the quarter pole then flattened in the drive. DEL MAR DRAMA raced mid pack, went three wide to place a brief bid then went evenly. LAST MINUTE JOE was forwardly placed early, went five wide and lacked a closing effort. STORMIN STORY saved ground to no avail. WACO JO was outrun, raced wide and was not a threat. DYNAMALT dropped back early to trail the field, raced well off the rail and was not a factor.
