Footnotes

DONA ANA was outrun early, raced five wide down the backstretch and into the lane, rallied nearing the eighth pole, wore down her rivals thru the stretch and was just up at the wire. EVER A BLURR was unhurried early, went four wide down the backstretch, placed a bid in mid stretch, was forced to alter inward between foes, gained a short lead at the sixteenth but was outfinished in the final strides. FOUND A PENNY drew clear quickly, held the advantage into deep stretch, drifted out some and yielded. GRAND JULIE was forwardly placed early between foes racing three wide into the backstretch, angled in near the three sixteenth and gave way along the inside. MISS BAMA BREEZE was off slow early and lacked a late response. QUEENAHEARTACHES chased the early leader while saving ground, drifted out into the stretch and faded.
