GLOVEDON'TFITAQUIT stalked the early leaders four wide, placed a bid nearing the quarter pole, dueled in the stretch then dug in and inched away in the final strides. PAGADOR was void of early speed racing along the inside, drifted out into the turn to circle the field, found his best stride late and was gaining. SHARP KANE forced the early pace, sustained a bid to gain a short lead at the quarter pole, was challenged in the stretch, dueled to nearing the wire then yielded. INDICATOR was within striking distance early, went five wide and lacked a late effort. CLEARANCE RACK showed some brief speed along the inside then tired. IRON AXE was unhurried early, angled in to save ground into the turn and lacked a bid. WHY FFFABULOUS was outrun, went wide into the stretch and was not a factor.
