Footnotes

QUITE A LINE was off slow early, raced wide down the backstretch, went six wide into the stretch, finished well and surged clear. THE ROAN BULL was void of early speed racing off the rail, angled out in the stretch and was gaining late eight wide. ANOTHERCHO was within striking distance early, rallied nearing the quarter pole to contend briefly into the stretch then flattened. TRICK RYDER set the early pace along the inside, drew clear, held to mid stretch then came up empty in the final going. A SURPRISE BULL was never far back and lacked a late effort. ROCK PROSPECTOR tracked the early leaders then faded after a half. SINGER'S PROSPECT was close in the early going along inside then gave way. TAT TWO RHYTHM was allowed to settle early and lacked a late response. BIT OF LARCENY failed to menace. NORANCHOYETTA retreated steadily.
