PAPA DO RIGHT was unhurried early racing off the rail, angled out four wide at the top of the stretch, placed a bid to duel with VINNY V. to the wire and was best late. VINNY V. pressed the early pace from the outside, vied to gain a clear lead at the eighth pole, was headed near the sixteenth pole, failed to match strides and was outfinished at the wire. SIZZLING FARGO was slow into stride leaving the gate, saved ground to nearing the quarter pole, began to close the gap some, then angled out three wide, showed some interest and gained the show. MAKE MINE VODKA was outrun early racing off the rail, was the widest in the stretch and showed some effort late. TAKIN ISSUE stalked the early leaders along the inside and lacked a closing response. NOBLE TRUTH set a pressured early pace, was used up early and came up empty in the stretch.
