Footnotes

SOARING N X S was outrun early racing off the rail, altered outward four wide at the top of the stretch, was full of run and exploded late to just get up. BLAZING SUPERSTAR forced the early pace from the inside, placed a bid in the stretch to gain a short lead but was denied at the wire by a fast closing rival. HERBAL SLEW set the early pace from the outside, was challenged nearing the eighth pole then yielded in the drive. LIVE AMMO was unhurried early racing off the rail, placed a brief bid near the eighth pole then went evenly late. HUNTIN A HALO was void of early speed, went four wide and showed some interest late. DEPOT RED raced mid pack, lost ground six wide into the stretch then came back and passed tiring foes. AINT HE A SCOOTER chased the early leaders racing off the rail, went four wide and was finished after a half. THATSNOLIE showed little saving ground and failed to menace.
